Between Depression and Hope Euphoric weight and rhythmic traps

The Swiss rock band **Wind Current**, based in Winterthur (CH), moves somewhere between psychedelic, alternative, and grunge. Their sound is raw, honest, and expansive – driven by an energy that feels both dark and uplifting.

Inspired by the Californian neo-psych scene of the 2010s to now (*Oh Sees, Wand, Fuzz – Ty Segall*) and the impact of classic grunge songwriting, they build a sonic landscape that feels familiar yet explores new paths.

A sound caught between weight and forward motion

Wind Current's lyrics revolve around heavy, existential themes – inner battles, disillusionment, the loss of control. But rather than remaining in the pain, it becomes a starting point for an energy that pushes forward – rough, charged, and often euphoric.

This break from the classic grunge aesthetic – which tends to lean toward cynicism or nihilism – feels bold. And yet, Wind Current manages to find a voice that feels entirely their own. The positive force they draw from heavy psychedelia never feels artificial. It's a genuine part of how they deal with what weighs on them.

This results in a musical tension: euphoria in the face of chaos, beauty in the shadows. Their grunge remains dry and understated, their psych elements shimmer – often paired with rhythmic traps that feel like floorboards giving way beneath your feet. At times hypnotic, at others crashing like a tsunami – but always sincere.

This duality is already evident in their debut single <u>"Psychotic"</u> – a dark, surging track that kicks off with a wide, explosive riff, skillfully employs rhythmic stumbling blocks as a stylistic device, and transforms a sense of alienation into raw energy. There's no romanticizing of madness here – it's being lived.
